Internship Description

MSW interns will work closely with our school-based mental health providers. Interns will be connected with a therapist and one school community, and will have the opportunity to collaborate and work closely with our school-based team across sites.

Interns will work with their on-site supervisor to accurately diagnose and come up with treatment plans for students. Over the course of time, interns will provide individual therapy and possibly family therapy. They will support our grant tracking through accurate progress monitoring and timely paperwork. Interns will receive supervision, collaboration/sign off on completion of field forms.



About us

Canvas Health, a nonprofit Certified Community Behavioral Health Center, offers a comprehensive continuum of care for children and their families who struggle with mental health symptoms that impact their ability to function successfully at home, in school and within the community. With the support and award of the State's School-Linked Mental Health Grant, this work has grown to having staff embedded within 28 academic buildings throughout the Twin Cities metro area.

Internship Sites

Interns will be placed in one of the following locations: North St. Paul/Maplewood (two middle schools); South Minneapolis (one elementary school); Forest Lake Middle School; or Pankalo, a Level 4 elementary school in Lake Elmo.

Clients

Interns will provide care for students with struggles related to mental illness, chemical dependency, poverty, academic difficulties, trauma, and behavioral challenges.

Relationships

Interns will build relationships with school mental health teams, offering ancillary support to school teachers and social workers.
